Nothing beats a cool cocktail on a warm evening — unless, of course, that cocktail is accompanied by a knockout rooftop view. San Francisco has scores of fun places to imbibe, but these not-to-miss spots will (literally) elevate your usual night out on the town.



1 Rooftop at VIA 138 King St., SoMa/Yerba Buena

Raise a glass atop the Hotel VIA in SoMa. The hotel's Rooftop at VIA is a chic indoor/outdoor space complete with captivating views of the downtown skyline, Bay Bridge, East Bay and AT&T Park. Open-air fire pits and comfy seating create a relaxed vibe. You'll slip right into a celebratory mood thanks to VIA's warm service, sophisticated drink menu, tasty tapas and sweets. Rooftop at VIA is truly exclusive; it's available only to hotel guests or by renting one of the swanky sixperson cabanas.

2 Charmaine's 1100 Market St., Central Market

Step off the San Francisco Proper Hotel elevator and straight into the playfully opulent atmosphere of Charmaine's, Perched 120 feet above the hustle and bustle of Market Street, this indoor/ outdoor escape boasts a glittering backdrop of city lights and a dazzling array of cocktails to match it. The creative bartenders can mix something up to please any palate, whether you're in the mood for a quirky concoction or a classic Old Fashioned. The snack selection fits right in with Charmaine's luxeyet-cheeky theme. Don't miss the hot dog dressed up with Bavarian mustard and fermented lettuce.

3 The Starlight Room 450 Powell St., Union Square

Want a reason to break out your party clothes? Look no further than the iconic Starlight Room, located on the 21st floor of the Sir Francis Drake Hotel. Take in the bird'seye view of Union Square directly from the dance floor or settle into a plush, high-backed booth for some good old-fashioned peoplewatching. If you're running with a crowd, the extensive drink list includes tasty spiked punch bowls for sharing. On Sunday, come back for the Sunday's A Drag brunch, featuring raucous routines by fabulously attired drag queens and transgender performers.
